# **DE PAUL CAMPUS FUTURE PLANNING** A New Opportunity for Montebello, California



Since the early 1950s, the Vincentian Community and the De Paul Center have served Montebello and the surrounding communities through their many spiritual and educational ministries. In 2018, the Vincentian Family began their 13 Houses Campaign, inspired by the 13 houses St. Vincent de Paul built for poor youth in France during the 1600s.

Mercy Housing California is the California-based affiliate of Mercy Housing, Inc., a national non-profit committed to serving communities by providing a wide range of housing types and high-quality management services. In addition, Mercy Housing has partnered with local neighborhoods and market rate developers throughout the state to create and implement innovative, thoughtful master plans, often assisting religious communities to rethink and repurpose their underutilized home campuses.

In the spirit of this worldwide campaign, the Western Province is partnering with Mercy Housing California to explore ways to repurpose their 13-acre De Paul Center campus to meet the following goals:

- Improve the overall socioeconomic environment in the community Respond to the variety of housing needs in the community, with an emphasis on affordable housing
- Honor the Pansini family and the Vincentian history in Montebello

The property, located at 420 Date Street, offers an exciting opportunity to create new high-quality, much-needed housing for families and individuals.

Although planning is just beginning, it is imagined that the campus plan would include a variety of housing types intended for a mix of income levels, open space, and other amenities, thoughtfully designed and well-integrated into the surrounding neighborhoods.

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## **ABOUT THE VINCENTIANS**


